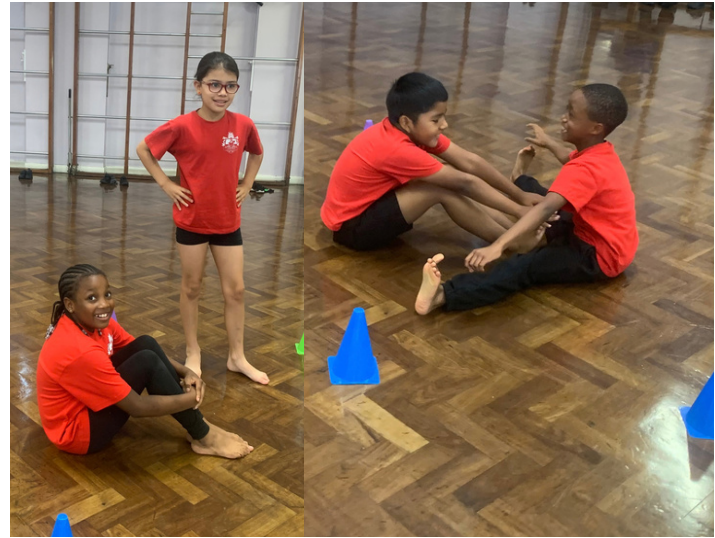
YEAR 3

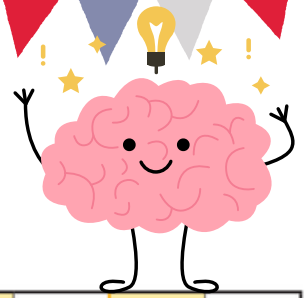
YEAR 6

Can you solve these maths problems?

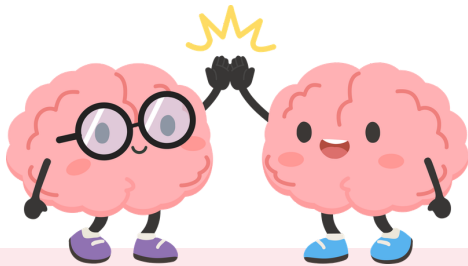


$$\text{Green Circle} + \text{Green Circle} = 10$$
