Home School Agreement

We believe that successful partnership between the School, the Church, the parents and the pupils helps each pupil to take full advantage of all that the School has to offer. The following Agreement supports this partnership in the interests of our children.

The School Will:

- Provide a balanced curriculum and varied opportunities for children.
- Encourage children to do their best at all times.
- Foster a Catholic Community that encourages children to care for each other and their surroundings.
- Let Parent(s) know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviour at school.
- Arrange Parent(s) Evenings during which progress will be discussed.
- Keep Parent(s) informed about school activities and events through a regular Newsletter and additional letters as appropriate.

The Parent(s) Will:

- Support the Catholic Ethos of the School.
- Support the school's aim for every child's attendance to be at least 97%.
- Make sure the child arrives for school on time and that they are properly equipped for the school day; this includes ensuring children read every evening and complete Homework set.
- Collect the child at 3.30pm each day, the impact on a child of not being picked up from school on time cannot be underestimated. The child that has been left behind will feel an increasing level of anxiety and distress the longer that they are unsure of where their parents are. Clearly this is not a good thing to happen to any child. The impact on the school of having a child left behind at the end of the day is also great as it requires two members of support staff to supervise that child. This means that those staff will not be able to undertake their duties in preparation for children's learning the following day and this also incurs an additional staffing cost to the school.
- Support the School's guidelines on pupil behaviour.
- Fully support and comply with Governor approved policies including the uniform code.
- Meet the high standards of behaviour expected as an adult role-model for all children.

- Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect the child’s work or behaviour at school and ensure the school is notified of any change in emergency contact numbers.
- Support the child’s progress at School by attending Parent(s) Evenings or Meetings scheduled by the school and by supporting children with their homework.
- Encourage the children to participate fully in the spiritual and worship life of the school.
- Support the school in encouraging the child to show respect for the local and wider community.
